Citizenship - This is a low-cost, 8-week-long program provided by the Immigration Attorney from our own Center for Citizenship and Legal Immigration. This course covers all aspects of the Naturalization test, including the civic questions, vocabulary, reading and writing, the naturalization application, and a mock naturalization interview.

Justice for All – Assistance for clients, who are interested in improving their academic levels, and or pursuing higher education, can count on MCOHA to help them achieve their goals. We provide after-school tutoring to children and assistance in applying to higher education programs and institutions through our Justice For All program, which aims to help children and families become connected with the community resources that address their needs.
